

## Online Leadership Track Activities Staff

### *Description*

The Online Leadership Track Activities Staff are responsible for facilitating various activities and games focused upon developing leadership, life skills, and personal development in a virtual environment during daily activities time. Additionally, they will be asked to assist with planning other activities for the campers as required. They will also build relationships with the teens and actively assist in other assigned camp activities and duties as required.

### *Responsibilities*

- Plan, develop and execute activities and games that help to develop leadership and personal skills for campers in a virtual environment
- Supervise students during these activities to ensure participant safety
- Debrief the activities and games and allow students to have a daily leadership and personal development “take home” to challenge themselves with
- Actively supervise and build relationships with the youth during other camp activities and assigned duties
- Attend briefing/debriefing sessions with Leadership Track staff on daily basis

### *Qualifications*

- Strong organizational ability with close attention to detail; able to plan in advance
- Able to communicate their plan and assign roles to staff
- Ability to plan and carry out a structured program within a team
- Ability to plan and execute tasks with little supervision
- Able to gather and utilize different resources within a budget
- Excellent interpersonal skills and team spirit: ability to motivate and inspire others to achieve optimal results
- Teachable, humble, and carries an attitude of selflessness and servant hood
