

Recreation Leader

Depending on funding: June 29 - August 7, 2026. 35 hours per week. This might change depending on funding.*

Job description: Recreation Leader is responsible for planning and running activities related to character building and leadership during Summer Camp.

Responsibilities:

- Plan, teach, and execute lessons about character building, and leadership. Use digital skills to teach lessons.
- Use different resources to build participants up so they will gain the confidence to contribute to society in a healthy manner.
- Build their leadership by creating projects that require teamwork and initiative.
- Actively supervise and build relationships with the participants.
- Ensure the safety of the participants by following the guidelines required for our programs.
- Provide administrative support: Registration, e-mails, phone calls, communicating with parents, managing budget, and others.

Requirements to apply:*

- Passionate and knowledgeable about character building, and leadership.
- Ability to plan and carry out a structured program within a team.
- Ability to plan and execute tasks with little supervision.
- Able to gather and utilize different resources within a budget.
- Effective communication and teaching skills.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and team spirit: ability to motivate and inspire
Teachable, humble, and carries an attitude of selflessness and servanthood.
- Emergency first aid training: Current First Aid & CPR certification.

*Funding might be coming from Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ). If funding is provided from CSJ, the applicant must be between age 15 to 30 and legally entitled to work in Canada. Applicants do not need to be a student.
